



## WHAT DOES PACE FUNDING DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

FACTS	
<b>Why?</b>	Financial companies must share your personal information with certain outside parties. Federal and state laws give consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. These laws also require us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information.
<b>What?</b>	The types of personal information we collect and share can include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Name and Address</li> <li>• Social Security Number</li> <li>• Account Balances, Date of Birth, and Payment History</li> <li>• Credit History and Transaction History</li> </ul> When you are no longer our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.
<b>How?</b>	Below are the reasons financial companies may share their customer's personal information; the reasons PACE Funding chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

## WHAT WE DO

How does PACE Funding protect my personal information?

To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include:

- Secure computers and servers
- Data encryption
- Limiting access to only authorized and qualified personnel
- Secure physical files and buildings.
- Verification procedures to confirm customer identity before processing a credit application or releasing information.

How does PACE Funding collect my personal information?

We collect your personal information, when you apply for an assessment. We also collect your personal information from credit bureaus and other companies.

Why can't I limit all sharing?

Various federal and state laws as well as financial business practices require us to share data about your financing with certain parties. None of these parties will contact you for marketing purposes

What is CCPA and how does it affect my data with PACE Funding?

- The California Consumer Protection Act went into effect Jan. 1, 2020.
- Under this law, PACE Funding must delete consumer's personal data at consumer's request after verifying the identity of the person making the request.
- Because we are required to store data on all assessments, we can only delete your information in situations where an exception to CCPA does not exist, such as if the application was denied or the project was cancelled prior to funding.

## DEFINITIONS

**Affiliates**

Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial or non-financial companies.

- PACE Funding has no affiliates

**Non-Affiliates**

Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial or non-financial companies.

- Bond Investors, auditors, attorneys, bond rating agencies, etc.
- Non-affiliates we can share with can include non-financial companies such as home

**Joint Marketing**

A formal agreement between non-affiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.

- PACE Funding does not currently participate in joint marketing with non- affiliates.
